Accounting Period

Revenue recognition

Foreign currencies

Transactions in foreign currencies are accounted for in Pakistani Rupoes at the average rate. Monetary assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into Rupees at the rate of exchange which approximates to those prevailing at the balance sheet date. Exchange differences are taken to the Receipts and payments account.
